The tail is about 19-40cm (7.5ich-16inc) bushy with 4-6 alternating black and brown or brownish grey rings.

Have 5 toes in front; 7.5cm long, 5 toes in hind legs and 8-11cm long. The ears are pointed, dark base and lighter

at the tips. Have long canines. Droppings generally cylindrical uniform in diameter about 5 cm long, granular textures.



Details - raccoon

Considered as a highly intelligent carnivore, and related to the bears and the giant panda. It is a nocturnal animal. It becomes a nuisance when it raids garbage bins in homes.

Food preference

The raccoon feeds on both plant and animal food sources such as fish, meat, fruits, nuts, small grains and other foods.
