General information on the spider

The Spider is divided into two segments, with a thin waist. The head and thorax is fused with jaws, two palps, eight legs and eight eyes. The unsegmented abdomen holds the spinneret. The daddy-long-legs (harvest-man) spider is different from other species because abdomen is segmented, 12 species are found around homes on wall, ceilings, window corners, or around outdoor lighting where insects fly around.

Some species of spider spin webs for catching prey but some don't spin webs and live on the ground.

Preventative measures

Two species are dangerous to humans, the black widow and the brown recluse. Spiders feed on other insects, general good sanitation reduce the chance of home infestation and therefore reduce possible harm to humans.
